
A CLOSER LOOK

Tenant improvements trump multi-family residential

Most contractors in the top 25 said they were awarded tenant improvement projects in 2010, with nearly 21 of survey respondents receiving that type of work. Corporate office projects took second place this year with 20 respondents doing that type of work. SC Builders Inc. declined to provide a sample of the type of construction projects they were awarded in 2010.
